<u>Administration</u>

- NSWRHA reserves the right to change the program and monies at their discretion and without notice.
- Breaks and class commencement times may be amended as required by the committee without consultation.
- Communication during the Show will be by announcement, Facebook, and notices. Please be aware of all communications.
- Arena maintenance will be reviewed daily, and a pen closure schedule will be posted in the office daily and maintenance will be conducted as required, whether notified or not.
- Pay times: must be booked and paid. Please check paid time slots and open pen times which will be posted at the show office and via social media each day If the show runs late, paid time starts will be pushed back, the same number of hours will still be run.

Entries and Conduct of Classes:

- Entries are to be received no later than midnight Monday 24 June 2024. Payment must be made via credit card or PayPal.
- LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted for new horses until midnight Friday 28 June 2024 and will incur a \$50 late fee
- Late entries will thereafter be accepted at the show ONLY for horses already entered in the show and MUST be received in acceptable order by the show office by 5PM the day prior to the class a late entry fee of \$30 per horse per class applies. All late entries will be placed at the top of the draw. Please note that if a rider is not already entered in the show, documentation of their membership & non pro status (if applicable) will need to be sighted. Any incomplete or incorrect entries will not be accepted
- Entries will only be finally accepted once all fees have been paid.
- All competitors are eligible to compete in non-sanctioned events. You must hold either an NSWRHA membership or NRHA membership. Classes will be run as per NSWRHA/NRHA rules. These can be found on the www.nswrha.com.au.
- Exhibitors for sanctioned classes: Owner/Co owners and riders must be current financial members of NRHA. All horses must hold an NRHA competition license. If this is the first time you have shown with NSWRHA this show season a copy of all membership cards and license must be provided.
- Exhibitors for sanctioned classes: Owner/Co owners and riders must be current financial members of NRHA. All horses must hold an NRHA competition license. If this is the first time you have shown with NSWRHA this show season a copy of all membership cards and license must be provided.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have checked their current eligibility status for classes. Failure to do so may result in forfeiting all entry monies, placings and any winnings. NRHA eligibility should be checked with Reiner Suite, https://reinersuite.nrha.com and using the Oceania drop down menu.
- Only NRHA members can partake in NRHA classes. Anyone that enters an NRHA class without the correct membership will be scratched and monies lost, including all fees associated with the class.
- NSWRHA Non-Members or non-members of one of the affiliated Oceania clubs must pay an event membership to NSWRHA for insurance purposes or become a full member of NSWRHA. Event membership does not include entry for NSWRHA Highpoints. A waiver must be signed.
- To check your eligibility for NSWRHA run classes please refer to the documents and link section on the NSWRHA website. www.nswrha.com.a
- NSWRHA highpoints will be in accordance with the classes defined in the NSWRHA rules.
- Prize Money payments for NRHA sanctioned classes will be in accordance with NRHA payback schedule A and B unless stated otherwise and will comply with all payout rules outlined in the 2024 handbook.
- Drags of the pen, between and during a class will be at the discretion of the Committee.
- NSWRHA reserves the right to change the program and monies at their discretion and without notice and reserves the right to modify this event schedule and classes after actual entry numbers are known.
- Classes will be operated at the discretion of the Committee and in accordance with the NRHA Handbook of Rules & Regulations 2024. By way of making an entry you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out in the 2024 handbook.

- It is the rider's responsibility to be appropriately attired in accordance with NRHA dress codes and courtesy to the Judge and fellow competitors.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have checked their current eligibility status for classes. Failure to do so may result in forfeiting all entry monies, placings and any winnings.
- 4YO Futurity: The futurity is open to four-year-old horses age eligibility per NRHA rules (Section 3b(1) on page 43 of the 2024 NRHA Handbook) and must be ridden one handed in a bridle or two handed in a snaffle bit/Hackamore. Prize money will be awarded for all levels as per NRHA payback schedules. Competitors are not required to enter all levels, and may enter the levels for which they are eligible.
- Derby: The derby is open to five-, six-, seven- & eight-year-old horses age eligibility per NRHA rules (Section 3b(1) on page 43 of the 2024 NRHA Handbook) to be ridden one handed in a bridle. Prize money will be awarded for all levels as per NRHA payback schedules. Competitors are not required to enter all levels, and may enter the levels for which they are eligible
- The NSWRHA Beginner class (class 6) is subject to NSWRHA rules.
- The Green Rider shootout (class 3) in 2024 works as follows:
 - The Green Reiner shootout works as such, the top 10 riders are then verified and go through to the Shootout class, from here all NRHA rules as well as judging rules apply.
 - The placings will be announced once all competitors have run.
 - Entry fee in the Green Reiner is for the first go around.
 - There is intended to be not more than 10 Riders to participate in the Shootout and all NRHA rules as well as judging rules apply.
 - Those riders will be selected from:
 - : 1. The top 10 overall scoring runs across both Green Reiner Levels 1 and 2 (Class 3); and
 - 2. A rider may only compete in the Shootout once, on one horse, irrespective of scores in class 3.
 - 3. If required, a rider must elect on which horse the rider wishes to compete in the shootout;
 - 4. The Show Committee have sole discretion to determine final number of competitors in the shootout, eligibility and the order of run in the Shootout;
 - 5. There will be no drag of the pen within the Shootout; and the scores and placings for the Shootout will be announced at presentation once all competitors have run:
- Failure to present to the gate marshal for their position in the draw will result in forfeiting their run in the class and all associated fees. Do not harass or attempt to persuade the gate marshal.
- Freestyle: Riders must hold a current NRHA membership and horses must have a NRHA competition license. These classes will be run in accordance with the NRHA rule book.
- Competitors must supply their own music for the freestyle, which must be in the hands of the office staff no later than **Friday** 5th July 2023 by 5pm
- It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of any scratching's before them and to be ready for their run-on time.
- Scratching's must be communicated in writing to the Secretary at nswrha@gmail.com and accompanied by a signed official veterinary certificate or doctor certificate excusing horse or rider from competition, and then the following conditions apply:
 - 1. Scratching before entry closing date and before entry has been processed Full refund off all fees.
 - 2. Scratching after entry closing date and before entry has been processed Full refund less office fees.
 - 3. Scratching once show has commenced and horse/rider has not yet shown in a class Refund of judges/Video fees
 - 4. Scratching once show has commenced and horse/rider has already shown in a class no refund of any
 - 5. No refunds for cancellations on the day of your class
- If there is a tie for first place, a run-off will be offered as per NRHA rules.
- Subject to Committee discretion, Prizes will be done until 5th place only.

Fees:

- Only one video and judges fee applies for concurrent classes. In the event a rider enters more than one concurrent class, the higher Judge's fee (if applicable) is payable (e.g. Open& Non-Pro).
- An admin fee is payable for all horse and rider combinations, including for open pen.

<u>Draws:</u>

• **DRAWS**: classes will be run as drawn and published (with exception on Non-Pro and Open, see below), with any approved late entries placed at the start of the classes.

Pen Rules:

- A maximum of 4 horses will be allowed in the Pen gate warm area at once. This will be the next 4 horses for the class. Please exit the gate area once your run is complete. Please ensure this area is free for working horses.
- There is a limited designated waiting area if not working. If your run has concluded, please leave the area.
- Open Pen NSWRHA Warm Up/ Schooling policy will apply. Circles for the first 30 mins of each hour fencing/stopping for the second 30 mins of each hour. Competition numbers must be worn in all open pen sessions.
- Only 14 horse rider combination allowed in open pen at any one time for the safety of riders and horses.
- Open pen will be open as advised. The arena pen will not be open or lit overnight.
- Open Pen and paid times will not be available until advertised/advised on Monday 1st July.
- Please check paid time slots and open pen times which will be posted at the show office and via social media each day If the show runs late, paid time starts will be pushed back, the same number of hours will still be run.

KRanch:

- Competitors can bump into K RANCH from Tuesday 2nd July 2024 @2pm
- Camping and stabling will be managed by K RANCH and can only be booked through nominate.
- Extra bedding will be available for sale at K Ranch. No outside bedding to be used in K Ranch stables to minimize spread of diseases.
- K Ranch site conditions, Dogs, animals, pets: <u>All dogs are to be on a leash and not allowed inside the main building, in the bar area or near the arena or grandstands.</u>
- All buildings are NO SMOKING ZONES including the Stables, Arena, Western Store and Seating Areas.
- The placement or affixing of advertising material (including posters), other than on Public Notice boards which are for this purpose, is not permitted without prior approval by K Ranch Management There shall be no tents allowed on site

General:

- **Social Media Policy** NSWRHA and the Show Committee support the social media Policy and all entrants, competitors, members, affiliates and spectators are taken to accept and abide by that policy.
- **Videography:** The official videographer for this show is Paul Newport. Video fee is compulsory unless the class is exempt (class any handed). The video fee does not entitle a rider to a video copy of the run.

- **Cancellation Policy** Full refund for a Vet Certificate or Doctors Certificate provided prior to the show. No refunds for cancellations on the day of your class, no refunds once class is drawn.
- The committee is conscious about the safety of our youth riders. Youth riders must; wear a helmet. If a youth rider wishes to wear a cowboy hat, parent's consent must be provided to the committee in writing prior to the class being held
















Welcome to The K Ranch




