ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE A CURRENT 2025/6 NSW RHA MEMBER PRIOR TO ENTRIES COMPETING OR HOLD A EVENT MEMBERSHIP

ENTRIES AND STABLES VIA JOTFORM

PROGRAM AND SCHEDULE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT NSW RHA DISCRETION.

NSW RHA RESERVE THE RIGHT AND ALL DISCRETION TO ACCEPT OR REJECT ANY ENTRY.

- 1) The NSW RHA strongly recommends that all riders wear a hard hat whilst riding.
- 2) A competitor number will be provided to the competitor and must be displayed on the left rear corner of the saddle blanket. Bit inspection may be performed at the judge's discretion or as requested by show management at the end of a pattern.
- 3) Only one judge's fee applies for concurrent classes.
- 4) Horses entered in both events in concurrent run classes will have only one run, and that score will count for both events.
- 5) Non-NSW RHA members must either complete a membership form and pay for annual or day membership or provide details of their affiliate membership prior to riding in any class for insurance purposes. Day membership does not include eligibility for NSW RHA high points, and a waiver must be signed.
- 6) As per the Model Rules for Associations incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act 1984, Part 3, Clause 13:
 - The committee is to be called the Committee of Management of the association and, subject to the Act, the Regulation, and these rules, as well as any resolution passed by the association in a general meeting,
 - It is to control and manage the affairs of the association,
 - It may exercise all functions that may be exercised by the association, other than those required by these rules to be exercised by a general meeting of members,
 - It has the power to perform and do all such things as appear to the committee to be necessary or desirable for the proper management of the association's affairs (including, but not limited to, club membership and show entries).
- 7) Only riders who are NSW RHA members can compete for NSW RHA high points, as per NSW RHA rules. NSW RHA high points will be awarded in accordance with the classes defined in the NSW RHA rules. For example, Youth 14-18 and Under 13 will be grouped for the purpose of NSW RHA high points.
- 8) Classes will be operated exclusively in accordance with the NRHA Handbook and its rules and regulations. By making an entry, you assume responsibility for and bind the owner, rider, and/or agent to the terms and conditions set out therein.
- 9) Show management reserves the right to modify the schedule after actual entry numbers are known.
- 10) Cancellation Policy: A full refund will be issued if an event or doctor's certificate is provided prior to the show. No refund will be given for cancellations on the day of the show.
- 11) Youth riders must wear a helmet.
- 12) A \$15.00 fee will apply for any lost or damaged prize money cheques that need to be reissued.
- 14) Late entries will be accepted on the day of competition.
 - For horse/rider combinations not previously entered, the late fee will be \$30 per class.
 - For horse/rider combinations already entered, the late fee will be \$5 per class, with a maximum of three late entries allowed.
- 15) NSW RHA reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to accept or reject any entry.
- 16) **Paid times will be in a first in best dressed order.**
