2022 NSW RHA State Show Championships

About NSW RHA

The NSW Reining Horse Association, Inc., started in the mid eighties when a group of western horse people in the Sydney area got together to run reining and cow horse shows. In fact the association started as the N.S.W. Reining and Reined Cow Horse Association..

After the formation of the RHA in 1988, reining in Australia had at last a national body to champion the cause of reining on a national level. The club changed its name to the N.S.W. Reining Horse Association to better reflect the direction its members were taking. In the early years the club ran a full show program, including Western Pleasure, Trail, Hunter Under Saddle and Cow Horse classes every month.

In the early nineties, Dave Gardner started running the Western Showcase Series of shows at Horseworld. These shows were a huge success and really showed what reining could be if it was promoted correctly. It was after these shows that the decision was made to start having shows at this venue. A combination of a large arena and good surface made it the perfect place to have our State Show. 1993 was the first year that the NSW RHA held its State Show at Horseworld and although our show program was too ambitious with the show running 'till 3am the show was deemed a success with the standard being set for years to come.

The NSW Reining Horse Association has been around for 30 years and Australia is actually one of the oldest reining countries outside the USA

***' To rein a horse is not only to guide him, but also to control his every movement.
The best reined horse should be willingly guided or controlled with little or no apparent
resistance and dictated to completely.'***

WHAT IS REINING?

Reining is a western style of riding demonstrating tremendous agility in turning, stopping, lead changing and more. Reining is a judged event designed to show the athletic ability of a horse within the confines of a show arena. Competitors are required to run one of ten approved patterns. Each pattern includes small slow circles, large fast circles, flying lead changes, rollbacks over the hocks, 360 degree spins done in place, and exciting sliding stops that are the hallmark of the reining horse.

THE AGENCY

If you intend to bring your dog it must be restrained at your campsite & always on a lead if moving around the stable & camping areas. Please be mindful of other guests, humans & horses, who all need their rest throughout such a big event.



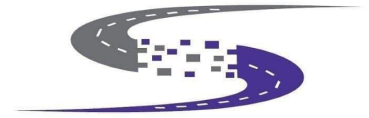

SHOW CONDITIONS

Refer also to the NRHA Handbook & NSW RHA rules www.nswrha.com.au :

- Entries are to be received no later than midnight Sunday 11th September 2022 Payment must be made via credit card or Paypal.
- LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted for new horses until midnight Sunday 18th September 2022 and will incur a \$50 late fee
- Late entries will be accepted at the show ONLY for horses already entered in the show and MUST be received in acceptable order by the show office by 5PM the day prior to the class – a late entry fee of \$30 per horse per class applies. All late entries will be placed at the top of the draw. Please note that if a rider is not already entered in the show, documentation of their membership & non pro status (if applicable) will need to be sighted. Any incomplete or incorrect entries will not be accepted.
- All competitors are eligible to compete in non-sanctioned events. You must hold either an NSW RHA membership or NRHA membership. Classes will be run as per NSW RHA/NRHA rules. These can be found on the www.nswrha.com.au
- Exhibitors for sanctioned classes: Owner/Co owners and riders must be current financial members of NRHA. All horses must hold an NRHA competition license. If this is the first time you have shown with NSW this show season a copy of all membership cards and license must be provided.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have checked their current eligibility status for classes. Failure to do so may result in forfeiting all entry monies, placings and any winnings.
- Classes will be operated exclusively in accordance with the NRHA Handbook of Rules & Regulations 2022. By way of making an entry you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out in the 2021 handbook
- Competitors can bump into K RANCH from Sunday 2nd October 2022. Camping and stabling will be managed by K RANCH and can only be booked through nominate
- Extra bedding will be available for sale at K Ranch. No outside bedding to be used in K Ranch stables to minimize spread of diseases.
- Prize Money payments for NRHA sanctioned classes will be in accordance with NRHA payback schedule A and B unless stated otherwise and will comply with all payout rules outlined in the 2022 handbook
- NSW RHA reserves the right to change the program and monies at their discretion and without notice.
- Breaks and class commencement times may be amended as required by the committee without consultation
- Please check paid time slots and open pen times which will be posted at the show office and via social media each day – If the show runs late, paid time starts will be pushed back, the same number of hours will still be run.
- Arena maintenance will be reviewed daily and a pen closure schedule will be posted in the office daily and maintenance will be conducted as required, whether notified or not.
- DRAWS: classes will be run as drawn, with any approved late entries placed at the start of the classes. It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of any scratchings before them and to be ready for their run on time. Failure to present to the gate marshal for their position in the draw will result in forfeiting their run in the class and all associated fees. Do not harass or attempt to persuade the gate marshal.
- 4YO Futurity: The futurity is open to four year old horses - age eligibility per NRHA rules (Section 3b on page 41 of the 2022 NRHA Handbook) and must be ridden one handed in a bridle or two handed in a

- snaffle bit/Hackamore. Prize money will be awarded for all levels as per NRHA payback schedules. Competitors are not required to enter all levels, and may enter the levels for which they are eligible
- Derby: The derby is open to five, six, seven & eight year old horses - age eligibility per NRHA rules (Section 3b on page 41 of the 2022 NRHA Handbook) to be ridden one handed in a bridle. Prize money will be awarded for all levels as per NRHA payback schedules. Competitors are not required to enter all levels, and may enter the levels for which they are eligible
 - 3YO Snaffle Bit Futurity: The futurity is open to 3yo year old horses - age eligibility per NRHA rules (Section 3b on page 41 of the 2022 NRHA Handbook) and must be ridden two handed in a Snaffle Bit/Hackamore . Prize money will be awarded for all levels as per NRHA payback schedules. Competitors are not required to enter all levels, and may enter the levels for which they are eligible
 - Freestyle: Riders must hold a current NRHA membership and horses must have a NRHA competition license. These classes will be run in accordance with the NRHA rule book.
 - Competitors must supply their own music for the freestyle, which must be in the hands of the office staff no later than 12pm noon Tuesday 4th October 2022 by 5pm
 - Cystic Fibrosis: This is a Non Sanctioned Event. It is a third party fundraiser. You may only ride one handed. Non Pro riders only. Open to both ladies and men.
 - If there is a tie for first place, a run-off will be offered as per NRHA rules.
 - Only one video and judge's fee applies for concurrent classes.
 - An admin fee is payable for all horse and rider combinations.
 - Photography: The official photographer for this show is Ken Anderson. No other professional photographer will be permitted to shoot any part of the show without the committee's consent.
 - A maximum of 4 horses will be allowed in the Pen gate warm area at once. This will be the next 4 horses for the class. Please exit the gate area once your run is complete. Please ensure this area is free for working horses. There is a designated waiting area if not working. If your run has concluded, please leave the area.
 - Open Pen - NSW RHA Warm Up/ Schooling policy will apply. Circles for the first 30 mins of each hour fencing/stopping for the second 30 mins of each hour. Competition numbers must be worn in all open pen sessions.
 - Only 14 horse rider combination allowed in open pen at any one time for the safety of riders and horses
 - Social Media Policy – NSW RHA and the Show Committee support the Social Media Policy and all entrants, competitors, members, affiliates and spectators are taken to accept and abide by that policy
 - NSW RHA highpoints will be in accordance with the classes defined in the NSW RHA rules.
 - Show management reserves the right to modify this schedule after actual entry numbers are known.
 - Cancellation Policy – Full refund for a Vet Certificate or Doctors Certificate provided prior to the show. No refund\$ for cancellations on the day of your class
 - K Ranch site conditions, Dogs, animals, pets: - All dogs are to be on a leash and not allowed inside the main building, in the bar area or near the arena or grandstands.
 - All buildings are NO SMOKING ZONES including the Stables , Arena ,Western Store and Seating Areas.
 - The placement or affixing of advertising material (including posters), other than on Public Notice boards which are for this purpose, is not permitted without prior approval by K Ranch Management There shall be no tents allowed on site
 - The committee is conscious about the safety of our youth riders. Youth riders must; wear a helmet. If a youth rider wishes to wear a cowboy hat, parent's consent must be provided to the committee in writing prior to the class being held
 - NSW RHA Non Members or non members of one of the affiliated oceania clubs must pay an event membership to NSW RHA for insurance purposes or become a full member of NSW RHA. Event membership does not include entry for NSW RHA Highpoints. A waiver must be signed.
 - All Buckles, stirrups, ribbons and trophies are dates 2021, the NSW RHA committee accepts these as they are and shall be presented as such
 - Only NRHA members can partake in NRHA classes. Anyone that enters an NRHA class without the correct membership will be scratched and monies lost, including all fees associated with the class
 - The Green reiner shootout works as such, your entry fee is for the first go around. There are no prizes and or money on the first go around. The top 10 riders are then verified and go through to the Shoot out class, from here all NRHA rules as well as judging rules apply. The placings will be announced once all competitors have run.

 - Prizes will be done until 5th place only
